## 2020 English Time in Use

### ORAL CONTEST



## PARTICIPANTS

All **2nd and 3rd of ESO** students from any high school in l'Alt Empordà can take part in this contest. So, as a new feature this year, the contest will have two categories (2nd and 3rd).

## RULES

- Participating students will work in groups of **3 to 5 students** to write and record a video sketch acting out a dialogue under the topic **Hosting a guest** (any dialogue taking place at someone's home or at some important settings in Alt Empordà, a conversation between a tourist guide or a host and some tourists who have just arrived in the region). The culture, the traditions and the lifestyle have to be reflected.
- **One group per school and per category.**
- The duration of the recording must be between **3 and 5 minutes**.
- The main language must be English. The use of any other language must be justified by context.
- Reading is not allowed.
- Students may use costumes and/or scene decor when acting out their dialogues.
- The recording must include a title at the beginning, but **it can't contain neither the name of the authors nor their school.**
- **Teachers must send their recordings** to [etoralcontest@gmail.com](mailto:etoralcontest@gmail.com) on the due date, mentioning the school, the names of the authors, the class and the category. - **In each category, 5 finalists** will be chosen to participate in the award ceremony where the champion video will be announced.

## DATES

Videos must be sent from the **2<sup>nd</sup> to the 5<sup>th</sup> of March 2020**

The award giving ceremony will be hold on the **28<sup>th</sup> March** at the Caputxins auditorium, Figueres  
The organization will contact the finalists before the ceremony to confirm their assistance.

## EVALUATION

A jury composed by people outside the English Time committee will mark each recording taking into account the following items: grammar richness, vocabulary variety, fluency and pronunciation, creativity/originality of the project and the quality of the production.



## PRIZE

The prize will consist of a gift card (for each category) to be shared with all the group members.
